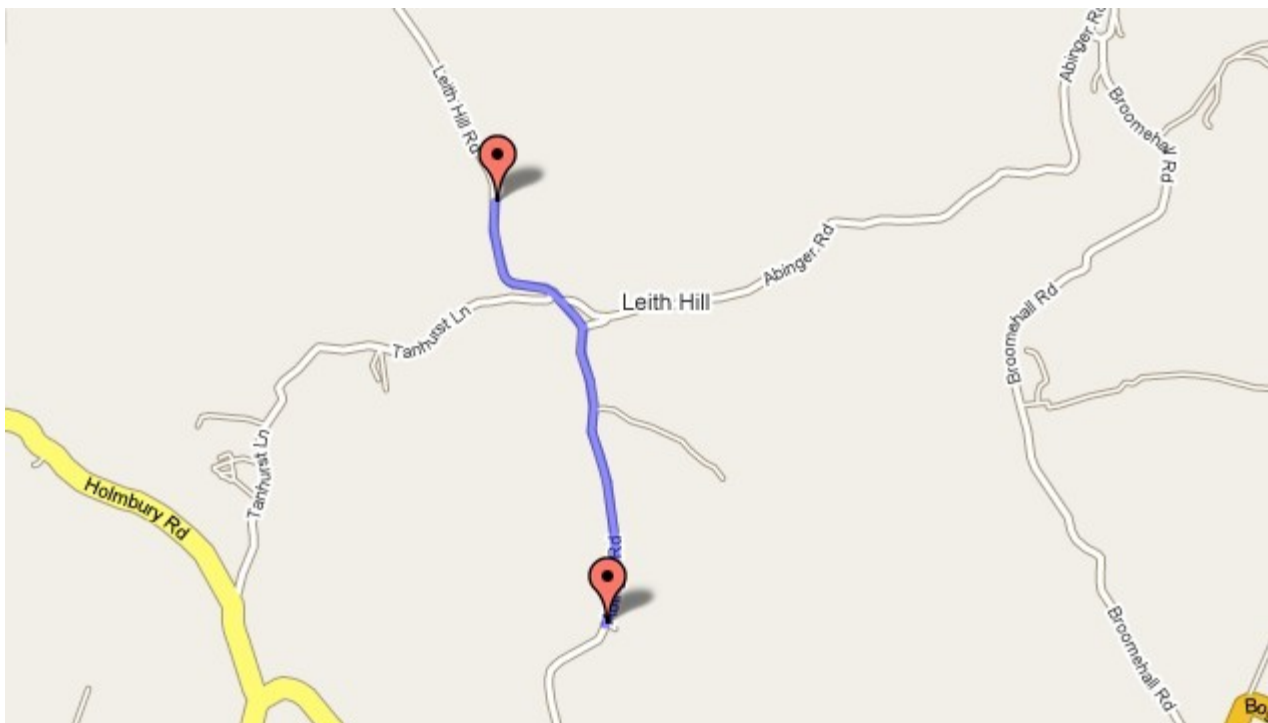

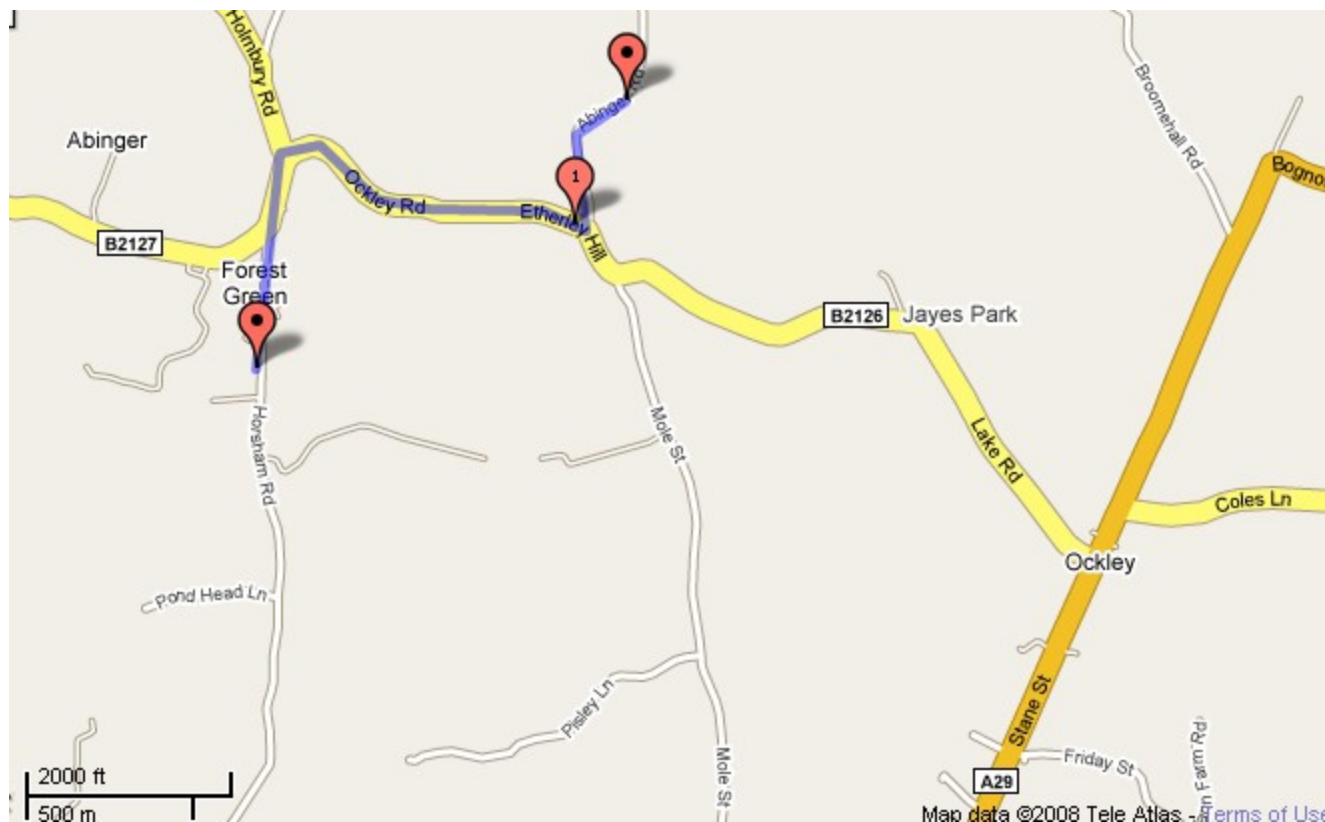
The GH/42 course:



Finding the HQ:

The race HQ is at Forest Green Village Hall which is situated in Horsham Road close to the Parrot Pub near the junction of the B2126 and B2127. Forest Green can be reached by following the B2126 from Ockley on the A29 (Slane St.).

Getting from the HQ to the start area:



Competitor notes:

Numbers should be collected from the race HQ. Riders must sign on when collecting their number.

Competitors are reminded that they will be “held” not “pushed” at the start and that anyone putting a foot down on the hill or walking will be disqualified.

Additional information:

London South District Regulation: No vehicles shall be parked on the highway within sight of the starting and finishing points.

Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started.

Details of any hazards not listed on this start sheet will be displayed or advised at the signing on point. All competitors must take note of these details when they sign on.

Local Area Requirements:

There are good toilets at the HQ, please use them rather than anywhere else

No riding ‘three abreast’

No swearing or hand gestures at car drivers

Please be respectful of horse and their riders – do not ride up behind them quietly so as to startle the horse!
